



18 Holes w/o pass 20 Rds. X \$39 = \$ 780.00 18 Holes w/pass 20 Rds. = \$ 750.75 \$29.25 Savings

(Save \$1.46/Rd.)

9 Holes w/o pass 40 Rds. X \$28 = \$1,120.00 9 Holes w/pass 40 Rds. = \$ 750.75 \$369.25 Savings

(Save \$9.23/Rd.) Golf Leagues

9 Holes w/o pass 40 Rds. X \$24 b = \$ 960.00 9 Holes w/pass 40 Rds. = \$ 750.75 \$ 209.25 Savings

(Save \$5.23/Rd.)

# How many 18-hole rounds need to be played to pay for your pass?

Single \$1,823.25 divided by \$39/round = 47 rounds (1 person)

Couples \$2,627.63 divided by \$78/round = 68 rounds (2 people)

### A LETTER FROM A MEMBER

In April 2025, I will be paying my Elks' dues for the 27th time. I have participated in many of the Elks' activities over the years where my marital status never mattered. In 2009 The Elks sold the downtown lodge and purchased Northwood Hills Country Club. Our membership grew from 575 to over 2,200 members. Going from a modest lodge on High Street to a lodge armed with a full-service restaurant, swimming pool, and golf course was a dramatic change for members, officers and trustees.

In the beginning, we used the Northwood Hills' template for golf pricing. There were several options to choose from such as Single, Senior Single, Family, Senior Family and Junior Executive etc. A notice was sent to the members requesting a reply by January 31, 2011, regarding their commitment to purchase a golf membership for the 2011 golf season. After reviewing the information received. the golf committee decided to change the golf membership template. They narrowed it down to an Individual (Single) pass and a Family pass and reduced the rates.

This format continued with various options and rates until 2020 when they offered an unlimited golf pass with a cart and an

unlimited golf pass for walking. The "single" and "family" rates and monikers were discontinued. It was one price for all Elk members regardless of marital status. This seemed to be the fair thing to do as we didn't have "couple" rates for Elks' membership dues or "couple" rates for bowling in the Elks' league so why did we have it for golf?

For some unknown reason in 2021 the golf pricing structure returned to the single vs couple pricing again and continues to this day. My question or statement made in the February 5 Lodge meeting is as follows:

In 2020 every Elk member paid either \$1,200 or \$1,400 depending on whether you purchased your pass before or after February 1.

Now, in 2025, a single Elk golf membership fee is \$1,700 and a couples' Elk golf membership fee is \$2,450 (\$1,225 each). This is a 42% increase in the fee for singles and only a 2% increase in the fee for couples since 2020. The golf course is not profitable so how can we so easily dismiss the extra \$950 of revenue per couple that we lose by having a "couples" pass" (\$3,400 vs \$2,450 = \$950)?

My question to the Trustees, "Why do we have a couple' pass?"

I am still waiting for an answer.
